

How do we prepare? Peter gives us the answer in the next verse, "But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ."

As we enter a new year together, I want to encourage you to spend a little more time each day with God. Perhaps this means a few more minutes each day in prayer, or a few more minutes looking at the Word of God. I promise you this—when difficult times come (and they will come), a firm foundation of faith in Christ and regular prayer and dialog with our Savior can make those tough times far easier to endure than if we have been neglecting our relationship with our Lord. So, if you don't feel like you're ready for those trials, take some time now to prepare by nurturing your relationship with Christ. Just like an Illinois winter, a little preparation now can make those trials easier to endure.




Congregational Meeting




The Annual Meeting of the Congregation is scheduled for January 30th immediately following the 9:00 a.m. worship service.



The new plumbing and electrical work in the old nursery area has been completed (as far as it can be until the offices are moved) and the downstairs ceiling remains "open" for now until all the work in the area has been completed. The next steps is this area include installing the new office windows and installing the drywall.

Unfortunately the outside demolition is still on hold until the contractor can get here. While we know that everyone was hoping to see this phase begin before winter arrived and are anxious to see this work begin, everything seems to have been slowed down due to labor shortages.
